## **Can an attorney assist me with my veteran's disability claim?**

HVLP is now assisting veterans with veteran's disability claims and related issues.

## **I have a Will already. What other documents would I need?**

There are estate planning and guardianship documents that will prepare you and your family for an untimely death or incapacity.
